### CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Dear Resident,

COVID-19 is an unprecedented situation and the City of Ottawa is committed to protecting people and the community. The City continues to work closely with the industry and to comply with restrictions and recommendations provided by municipal, provincial and federal health officials, as well as the Ministry of Labour, Training and Skills Development.

Multiple notices have been previously issued to address impending construction for the renewal of sewers, watermains, roadways and sidewalks on Grove Avenue and Grosvenor Avenue. While design work for this project remains ongoing, construction has been delayed and is expected to commence in 2023 pending approvals, including budget and overall construction coordination. The timing for the project will be confirmed closer to construction. Please note that Enbridge works, previously detailed in a notice supplied in September, continue and remain on track for completion in late Fall.

**What:** The City of Ottawa is undertaking the design for the renewal of the infrastructure on Grove Avenue and Grosvenor Avenue. The proposed work consists of the renewal of the sewers, watermains, roadways and sidewalks.

**Why:** The existing watermain, sanitary sewer and road infrastructure has reached the end of its useful life and requires replacement to continue to provide the required level of service to your neighbourhood.

**When:** The design work for this project is ongoing. Construction is expected to start in 2023, pending approvals including budget and overall construction coordination. The timing for the project will be confirmed closer to construction.



# NOTICE TO RESIDENT

**Where:** The proposed work will occur on Grove Avenue from Brewer Park to Bank Street, and Grosvenor Avenue from Grove Avenue to Hopewell Avenue.

**Who:** The City of Ottawa has retained the consulting firm, Robinson Consultants Inc., to complete the design.

Further information of the plan, construction timing and impacts to the community will be shared in 2022, in advance of construction. Additionally, a notice will be supplied prior to construction inviting you to review and provide comments on the final design.
