IMPORTANT CAMP INFORMATION

What to bring to camp each day:

- Back-Pack
- Lunch & Snacks (no peanut/nut or peanut/nut by-products),
- Indoor Shoes
- Refillable Water Bottle
- Toque, Mittens, Snow Pants
- Winter Boots
- Winter Coat
- Anything else listed above

What Not to Bring

We strongly encourage campers not to bring electronic devices (e.g., video games, cell phones, cameras) unless they are needed for emergencies. We also don't recommend sending your child with money. Our staff are also not responsible for your child's valuables and money.

Camp Hours, Pick-Up, and Drop-Off

- All camps, unless otherwise noted, run from **9:00AM until 4:00PM**.
- **PRECARE:** 8:00AM-8:45AM
- **DROP OFF:** No later than 9AM at The Firehall (260 Sunnyside Ave)
- **PICK-UP:** No later than 4PM at Firehall unless you're registered for After-Care
- **AFTER-CARE:** If you purchased After-Care for the week, it will run from 4PM-5:30PM at the FIREHALL (260 Sunnyside Ave.)

Brief Safety Procedures

First Aid: Each camp group is equipped with first aid kits and all staff are certified in Standard First Aid, CPR Level C, and AED use (automated external defibrillator).

Out-Trips: We take the children on out-trips during camp. For local trips (e.g., Windsor Park or Brewer Park), campers will walk together with their counsellors. During these trips, counsellors perform multiple head counts: before leaving, once children arrive, throughout the day, upon leaving, and once they've returned. All places we go are approved by management and are also accessible by emergency medical services.

Dressing For The Weather: We will try to bring the group outside as much as possible so long as the weather cooperates and is not too cold. We'd ask that you send warm clothes and appropriate outdoor winter gear (toques, mitts, boots, coats, and snowpants) each day of camp. We also recommend sending a plastic bag just in case clothing gets wet in the snow.
