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Game Instructions

Marble Game

This particular marble game is usually played by two people. Each player needs only one marble. To decide who will start, draw a line on the ground. Each player then throws their marble as close to the line as possible. The closest to the line starts the game. The aim of the game is to hit your opponent's marble three times in a row. Each player takes it in turns trying to hit each other's marble. If the marble is hit, you get another shot. If it misses, it's your opponent's turn.

Balance Beam

You will need coloured masking tape (multiple colors for more fun) and a big enough space to play.

How to: Clear some space in a room and clean the floor. Stick the length of the tape to create straight or curved lines to walk on. You can use multiple colors and have unique rules for how the child can walk on them. For example, if the tape is blue, the kid has to walk with one hand on his head, or if it is green, he has to limp the stretch. The child has to follow the rules and walk only on the tape and not on open land! If he does, he's out.
